## **Space Age Chess Set**

### **Kevin's Story** (eBay ID: datoolgod)

My wife Wendy and I stopped at a small roadside yard sale. The sellers had 2 chess sets for sale, one with pieces made of marble and the other with wooden pieces. Wendy liked the marble set, but I was intrigued by the wood set. I negotiated a price of \$5.00 down from the asking price of \$10.00.

In my listing, I said that I believed the set dated from the 1950s. Ten minutes after I listed the set, I received an email from a friendly eBayer, informing me that the set was actually from the 1960s. I learned that he is president of an online chess set collectors club. He predicted that my set would sell for at least \$100, probably more like \$150, and if the right buyers were looking, as much as \$200.

He told me that wood sets are generally more sought after than stone sets. He also said there is a group of dedicated chess set collectors who follow chess set auctions, and he would probably recognize many of the bidders. Who knew?
